

INCREASE IN FEES FOR COURT-APPOINTED GUARDIANS OF MEDICAID
RECIPIENT INCAPACITATED PERSONS


AND NOW, this 12th day of July, 2023, in consideration of the *Policy*

Clarification, Medicaid-Long-Term Care, PMN-21139-468, issued by the Division of Health Services on or about November 22, 2022, increasing the permitted maximum monthly guardianship fee for guardians serving Medicaid recipients/indigent incapacitated person from One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per month to Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per month, effective January 1, 2023, it is hereby ORDERED that, beginning January 1, 2023, all current Greene County court-appointed professional guardians who receive monthly compensation in the amount of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars as outlined above, are now authorized to receive Three Hundred (\$300.00)

Dollars per month without the need to file a Petition for Fee Increase. The Greene County District Court Administrator shall post notice of this order on the Greene County Court of Common Pleas website as soon as reasonably possible and send copies of this order to all known professional/corporate court-appointed guardians.
